Key Symptoms of COVID-19

Fever (temperature of 37.8°C or higher) **and/or** New, continuous cough (coughing for more than I hour of three coughing episodes within 24 hours) **and/or** Loss or change in normal sense of smell or taste (anosmia) **Use NHS online symptom checker:** III.nhs.uk/covid-19/

You must book a test if you have any of the above symptoms, even if just one of them. If you need to book a test: https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/ or call 119 if you do not have internet access.
